Prayer recited by the lady of the house.

Four Cups of the Fruit of the Vine (Exodus 6:2-7)

1. The Cup of Sanctification

2. The Cup of Deliverance (Plagues)

3. The Cup of Redemption

4. The Cup of Praise

Kiddush - First Cup: The Cup of Blessing

All fill the cup, the leader recites the blessing, all drink leaning to the left.

Urchatz - Sanctification

Washing of hands before the meal

Carpas - Greens

Dipping of parsley in salt water

Yachatz - Unity

The leader takes the middle matzah, breaks it in two, puts one half back in the middle of the "matzotash", then he wraps the other half "Afikomen" in the white napkin and hides it.

Eser Makot - The Ten Plagues (**Recite & take a drop of juice out for each.**)
